

#### ABOUT THE DESIGNER

Denis Perrollaz is a French artist, born in 1965 in Madagascar. He spent his childhood in Africa and Germany. Arrived in France in 1982, he settled in Cannes in 1987 where he quickly began his career as a painter. His first works already show his interest in the material.

He naturally uses natural components such as earth pigments, tar, and metallic powders, recycled synthetic materials such as traffic signs, also the rust collected on the hulls of boats when he set up his workshop in Saint Barth.


The artist creates works illustrating the forgotten relationship between man and nature. He restores the balance between natural materials and industrial creations. His pieces remain as a testimony of the meeting. He often takes the forms of stars and planets, trees, or even horizons where your eyes can get lost.






#### ABOUT THE DESIGNER

After studying visual communication, Fabien Barrero-Carsenat joined the Superior School of Art and Design in Saint-Etienne for five years. He was thus able to benefit from an Erasmus exchange in Finland during which he was confronted with other practices. Subsequently, he obtained his master's degree in Design, more oriented towards research based on pine resin.

After graduating from Saint Etienne in 2012, the young designer went to work as an assistant designer in Pepe Heykoop's studio in Amsterdam, where he was once again able to confront experimentation and development around materials, in particular bake and scrap wood and certain metals.

Through his various projects, Fabien Barrero-Carsenat likes to honor the material, which takes first place in all of his production. He also takes care of each step of production of an object himself: "My interest was to be able to master from the first stroke of the pencil to the manufacture of the object, to be able to make my bronzes, manage my metal recipes, the alloy, to be able to make my own hollows and to be able to achieve a certain autonomy by also upgrading materials such as tin and copper which come from scrap objects from society contemporary. The idea that I have when I draw a piece, only have a projection of what the material will be able to offer me afterwards."



#### ABOUT THE DESIGNER

Marion Mezenge was educated at the Boulle School for six years. After graduating, the young designer studied the design and production of bespoke lighting for architects and decorators in Paris. She was also a project leader at the Fab-lab, Techshop-les ateliers Leroy Merlin in Paris. Alongside her different functions, Marion Mezenge founded, next to three designers, the Edward Tisson association, a collective and multidisciplinary workshop where craft and design converge.

In just a few years, Marion Mezenge has received some prestigious awards. In 2014, the designer was named Coup de coeur of the Avenir Métiers d'art prize, awarded by the Institut National des Métiers d'Art in Paris. Then, in 2019, the candlestick Dian was sectioned at the regional competition of Ateliers d'art de France.

The creations of the young French woman are often born from a questioning, from an observation that leads her to develop a collection for an answer. All the pieces are drawn and made by her in the heart of her workshop. Marion Mezenge also likes to collaborate with different skills while supporting the story of the object. The Astérie collection was worked with a skater for the shades of the Trinh and Ernest candlesticks, as well as with a chisel for the Trinh reflector. Her approach to creation is personal and empirical. It requires a constant return between the workshop, the material and the drawing with, always in common thread, the story that is created.



DIAN CANDLESTICK by Marion Mezenge

Candlestick in bronze, oiled brass and hammered brass.

#### DIAN CANDLESTICK

Hammered brass reflector, the branch is in bronze and brass, the reflector can be tilted to interact with the flame. The Dian candlestick has a height of 25 inches.

The works of primatologist Dian Fossey take us to the lush forest of Rwanda. There, she surveys every nook and cranny to better understand and protect an endangered population. Twilight announces the end of a day's walk. Warm rays settle in. The reflector is inspired by this time of day, when the light is hidden between the leaves of an opulent forest. The reflector can be swivelled and plays with this sometimes capricious light to better capture its intensity.

#### ERNEST CANDLESTICK

This candlestick was designed by Marion Mezenge in 2019. It is made in brass and glass, the base and bobeche with patina, the reflector is in glass and it can be inclined to interact with the flame. The Ernest candlestick has a height of 18,5 inches.

In 1914, Captain Sir Ernest Shackleton boarded the Endurance, a ship, to make his first attempt to cross the Antarctic. This epic in the polar regions, where nothing happens as planned, will last three years, including four hundred days of drifting. During this journey, Ernest and his crew will live in immense panoramas with subtleties of hues oscillating between greys, pale blues and several shades of white. Some evenings, these polar landscapes come alive with colour and the northern lights come to life for a night. The reflector can be rotated to discover, depending on the point of view, these plays of colour.

#### GERTRUDE CANDLESTICK

This candlestick was designed by Marion Mezenge in 2019. Gertrude belongs to the Astérie candlestick collection and is distinguished by its gold color's rendering, it is in bronze and oiled brass, the reflector is in polished brass. The Gertrude candlestick has a height of 18,5 inches.

The life of Gertrude Bell transports us to an arid world where desert crossings are made on horseback in the exhausting heat. As far as the eye can see, an immensity of warm tones, of burning sand. A virgin, smooth nature, where each imprint is erased by the next wind of sand. The sun is at its zenith, dazzling and omnipresent. The polished reflector captures this moment of the day, reverberates the light and invades the space.

The Astérie collection strives to transcribe the experience of light that these explorers lived in remote areas of the Earth: the zenith, twilight, night and the aurora borealis. Reading their stories has nourished the luminous intention and the aesthetics specific to each candlestick. The first name, as well as the finish of the pieces are nods to their work and the places where they lived.

#### THRINH CANDLESTICK

This candlestick was designed by Marion Mezenge in 2019. It is in bronze and brass oiled, the foot and the bobeche with patina, the reflector is in brass chiseled in collaboration with Constance Escal.

According to the course of the sun, the zenith and the night are opposed. They turn their backs. They are the negatives of both: one illuminates, the other reappears. Only the stars glitter. At this moment, Trinh Xuan Thuan observes them, he questions the galaxies. He tells us about luminous phenomena that have nourished our imaginations. Plunged into the tones of purple and black, only the flame of the candle illuminates the relief of this painting which takes place certain evenings, at nightfall.

The Thrinh candlestick has a height of 18,5 inches.



Made from the noble material of bronze, they reveal the contrast of its raw texture and its brilliance as a result of its machining. The underside of each piece is lined with felt to avoid scratching the surfaces on which it would be deposited.

Partners have been imagined to be faithful companions of your sweet moments of life. For a particular occasion, the bottom of the candle holder has the most important base perhaps personalized initials of his or her future buyers, a date or an age.

#### ABOUT THE DESIGNER

William Guillon is a French designer based in Bordeaux. Influenced by powerful artistic universes imbued with a certain modern melancholy, he is driven by love for the noble material and the raw material to work, to sublimate without altering it. Particularly attached to French craftsmanship and skill, he designs high-quality object works, without ever compromising aesthetics in favor of ease.

In 2014, a graduate of ECV Bordeaux, William Guillon founded his studio from a reflection around black. He has since edited several collections of functional sculptures and accessories but also worked on bespoke projects. Each of its numbered and limited edition creations for the most part is handcrafted in France and available in many finishes and materials. William Guillon is present in many showrooms around the world, notably in New York with the Philia Gallery, at Garde in Los Angeles, in the Hamptons at Michael Del Piero's gallery or at Raffles in Singapore.





#### AVALON

These candlesticks were made by William Guillon in 2019. Set of candlesticks in solid brass and metal (the gray part) sculpted and brushed by hand. Each set is composed of unique pieces, each piece is signed by the artist.

With these candlesticks William Guillon has returned to the essence of his project; the material. He wanted a simple, radical, massive and barely machined object to authentically feel the material that is used. The solid brass cylinder is textured and hand brushed by William then assembled to a solid block of cast iron. These pieces give the feeling of having been directly extracted from the earth to create these raw and timeless accessories.

#### TEMPLE VASE

Temple was born from the fire consuming Notre-Dame. Its three bronze arches make up a crown of columns, springing from the Earth. A ruin that would have passed through the ages. A structure polished by time. The archeology of the future, as a new narrative, to ward off destroyed History. A receptacle is then lodged in the heart. The reconstruction begins. A smoked glass gathers the pilasters, connects the grazing arches. From the ashes the vitreous matrix is created. In place of the void comes the container. Made in France by hand, unique piece.

#### ABOUT THE DESIGNERS

Through his various projects, Fabien Barrero-Carsenat likes to honor the material, which takes first place in all of his production. He also takes care of each step of production of an object himself: "My interest was to be able to control from the first stroke of the pencil to the manufacture of the object, to be able to make my own bronzes, manage my metal recipes, the alloy, to be able to do my own digging and to be able to achieve a certain autonomy by also upgrading materials such as tin and copper that come from discards of objects of contemporary society."

Eve George and Laurent Fichot, designers and glassblowers, work at Atelier George with four hands, from design to manufacturing. Their work revolves around lighting, tableware and wall tiles, all shaped by the techniques of molten glass, by hand. Each object in the Atelier is unique: thanks to the mastery of glass blowing, the objects are never reproduced identically.

#### ABSIDE VASE

Abside is the work of collaboration between Fabien Barrero-Carsenat and Atelier George, created in 2022. The Abside vase is composed of a crown of solid bronze arches, an amber glass blown into the structure itself and an insert of clear blown glass containing a sphere of dense, clear amber ribbed glass.

Eve George and Laurent Fichot, designers and glassblowers, work at Atelier George with four hands, from design to manufacturing. #### ABOUT THE DESIGNER

Denis Perrollaz is a French artist, born in 1965 in Madagascar. He spent his childhood in Africa and Germany. Arrived in France in 1982, he settled in Cannes in 1987 where he quickly began his career as a painter. His first works already show his interest in the material.

He naturally uses natural components such as earth pigments, tar, and metallic powders, recycled synthetic materials such as traffic signs, also the rust collected on the hulls of boats when he set up his workshop in Saint Barth.

The artist creates works illustrating the forgotten relationship between man and nature. He restores the balance between natural materials and industrial creations. His pieces remain as a testimony of the meeting. He often takes the forms of stars and planets, trees, or even horizons where your eyes can get lost.



#### ABOUT THE ARTIST

Vadim Garine was born in 1970 in the Tian-Chan, foothills of the Himalayas on the border of China and Kazakhstan. His encounter with Archimandrite Zenon, an internationally renowned monk and iconographer, was crucial in his artistic life. He acquired from him a knowledge of the various ancestral techniques, including tempera, encaustic, and gilding. In 1996, Vadim Garine moved to France. His time at the art restoration school allowed him to enrich his knowledge of ancestral techniques and to open his creation and restoration workshop. From 1999 to 2005, Vadim, while restoring the gilding of Chambéry Cathedral, received his first icon order (4m high) for the church of Colombier Sonnieux. Vadim exhibits personal and contemporary works in the Anne Jacquemin Sablon gallery, on supports such as wood, vegetable weavings, paint, cardboard, gilding, or aluminum.


#### **BLEUS LOINTAINS**



#### ABOUT THE ARTIST

Vernon is an emerging sculptor from the French art scene. He began his training with the French sculptor Véronique Lacomme and then turned to ceramics and painting. During his various apprenticeships, he went for long stays in the United States, a country he visited ardently and where he found his inspiration, notably from Harry Bertoia or Alexander Calder. But it was when he discovered the «Forms derived from a cube» by Sol LeWitt, an iconic American sculptor of the 20th century that he began to sculpt his heads and faces. Vernon first deals with movement in sculpture. This is where he finds the humanity of his characters in the simplest forms thanks to the suggestion of human postures: strength, grace, aggressiveness, melancholy, or expectation. Committed to the preservation of nature and humanity, he also sculpts his bases in materials from the earth and its history. He thus uses soft stones from the 17th century or timber from the 18th century as the basis of his works, between transmission and reuse.



# A PROPOS DE L'ARTISTE

#### ABOUT THE ARTIST

Jean-François Reboul is a sculptor, born in 1952 in Toulon. He graduated from École des Beaux Art in Avignon. From his first individual exhibition in 1980 at the Galerie Bernard B in Pont l'Abbé, he organized his exhibitions several times in Europe and has also took part in international fairs. His works are done with various materials that manufacture or transform (clay, cement, concrete, wood, glass paste, raw materials, coatings, plate, etc.) in symbolic and straightforward forms. The matter is substance and can be smooth and rough, white or black, subtle and delicate, or spliced and solid. No technique is prohibited because each material must serve its purpose, although it has its specificity. Reboul likes to appropriate new material as long as he understands to use it better.

The artist's current atelier was created already, back in 1982, where he began his journey with Raku technique having today over 30 experiences of a firing process developed in Japan in the late 16th century. Today Jean-François Reboul is inspired by astral figures, his vision of letting the material speak for its form. He varies his techniques and approaches depending on the argil – whether it is concrete used for the big art sculptures or ceramic for the utility creations.





#### ABOUT THE ARTIST

A few scattered silhouettes like sentinels in a garden, massive women and men, playing with absence and presence: Absence like beings who, deep within themselves, are so inhabited that they forget us; presence through their unequaled physical power, superhuman statures, protective and disturbing, humble and colossal, everyday women and men, builders of their form, anchored in a rough reality. These characters, Véronique Motte pulls them out of the clay, managing to obtain this impossible balance that gives these sculptures an impression of indestructible solidity. Never on a human scale, we do not copy God, they can be small too, but the same force animates them. Motte makes them Sumos in combat or Guardians of Joy. Tiny, they are hetaerae which, barely out of the marl, collapse on the beach. When they are in the ground, Véronique sometimes dresses them in light veils of kaolin, or leaves them like that, raw in their disarming nudity. When they are in bronze, the patinas give them the colors of passing time without hurting them anymore. Because wounded, they are, not in their unassailable bodies, but by their impassable and always useless, and always solitary bodies. And when they are serene and smooth, like the beautiful Italian, all the sensuality is exhaled in a volute with the scent of tender sweetness. Véronique Motte the Flamande has transported her know-how, her imagination, her characters, and her immense talent to the South.

### ABOUT THE ARTIST

Adolf Ryszka, born in 1935 and died in 1995, is an essentially figurative sculptor. He is particularly renowned in Poland for his long series of busts and heads of the cellist Pablo Cassals, who, like Beethoven for Bourdelle, was one of his favorite subjects throughout his life. However, the sculptor devoted himself, at the same time, in the mid-1960s, to a more abstract representation to create monumental works. The charisma of the character, student of the Academy of Fine Arts in Warsaw, and professor in charge of the sculpture department of Applied Arts at Copernic University in Torun from 1957 to 1962. The varied character of his production, both about the subjects and materials (plaster, bronze, stone, marble, etc.) allowed him to leave an important impression on the following generations of Polish sculptors. Adolf Ryszka has also received more than ten sculpture prizes and has had many personal exhibitions in Poland and around the world. His works are preserved in the national collections of the Museum of Krakow, in Poznan, in Warsaw, in Wroclav and at the National Museum of Lotz, but also at the Joan Miró Foundation in Madrid and the Museum of Modern Art of the city of Paris.
